## Program Fees

- annual tuition fee of $\$ 2,000.00$ per student, which will be spread out over 8 monthly payments of $\$ 250.00$.

## Registration information

- Submit the EC Application and a \$250 nonrefundable deposit made out to CCUSD 301. Application and deposit is then sent to Michelle Vaughn Assistant Director of Student Services (deposit will be applied towards tuition)


## Program Information

- Classes are held 5 days per week, Monday through Friday.
- The morning session is for 3 -year-olds.
- The afternoon session is for 4 -year-olds.
- Non-IEP students must be toilet trained by the start of school in order to participate in the program.
- Families will need to provide transportation as bus transportation is not available.
