Third grade families and students should enter through the front door near the flag pole at 6:45 PM. The students will go to their classroom and sit in their assigned seat before the concert begins. Families will pick up their children by their coat hooks outside of their classroom when the concert is over. Students and visitors must wear a mask at all times while inside the school building.

5th Grade had fun during our first snow fall of the season!



2nd Grade: 6:00 - 6:30

Second grade families should enter the school through the **South doors**. School doors will be unlocked at 5:45 PM. Second grade students should sit in **their** assigned cafeteria seat (where they sit for lunch) before the concert begins. Families should pick up second grade students in the cafeteria after the concert and exit through the cafeteria doors.

3rd Grade: 7:00 - 7:30

Third grade families should enter the school through the **front doors**, **by the bus loop**. School doors will be unlocked at 6:45 PM. Third grade students should go to **their classrooms** before the concert begins. Families should pick up third grade students at their coat hooks outside their classrooms after the concert.

In order to align with the District 301 Back-to-School Guidance, students will be spaced three feet apart on the bleachers this year, which will limit the amount of seating for our audience. In order to help ensure everyone has a place to sit, and to continue District 301's layered prevention strategies, please limit audience members to two per child whenever possible. In accordance with the state mandate, masks are required for all indoor school events.

The performance of our concert will be professionally videotaped, and DVDs may be purchased for \$10 each. The order form is below. Orders, with payment, must be received by the day of the concert. Since DVDs will be produced right away, late orders cannot be accepted.

Students should plan on wearing their class t-shirts, or a similar color t-shirt, and dark bottoms (ex. dark leggings or jeans).
