<u>Medication Pick Up Reminder</u> Medications kept in the Nurse's office will not be stored or transferred for next school year. If your student has medications at school, please plan a time to pick up these medications. Please note that medications can not be sent home with a student. A parent or guardian must pick them up by May 31st or they will be discarded. If you have questions, please contact the office.

<u>Reminder for Next School Year</u> ~ August will be here before we know it! Here is a list of school health exams that will be due for students entering these grades for the 2023.2024 school year. These forms should be submitted before your student starts school in August.

1. Health Requirements

- a. Physical Exams: Early Childhood/Preschool & Kindergarten Students
- b. Immunizations: Early Childhood/Preschool & Kindergarten Students
- c. Dental Exams: Kindergarten & 2nd Grade Students
- d. Eye Exams: Kindergarten Students Exams must be conducted by a licensed optometrist or a physician licensed to perform complete eye examinations.
- 2. Individual Health Plans and/or Medication forms must be updated/renewed each school year.
 - a. Students who "self-carry" epi-pens or inhalers must have an updated healthcare plan and parent consent to self-carry-on file in the Nurse's office.
